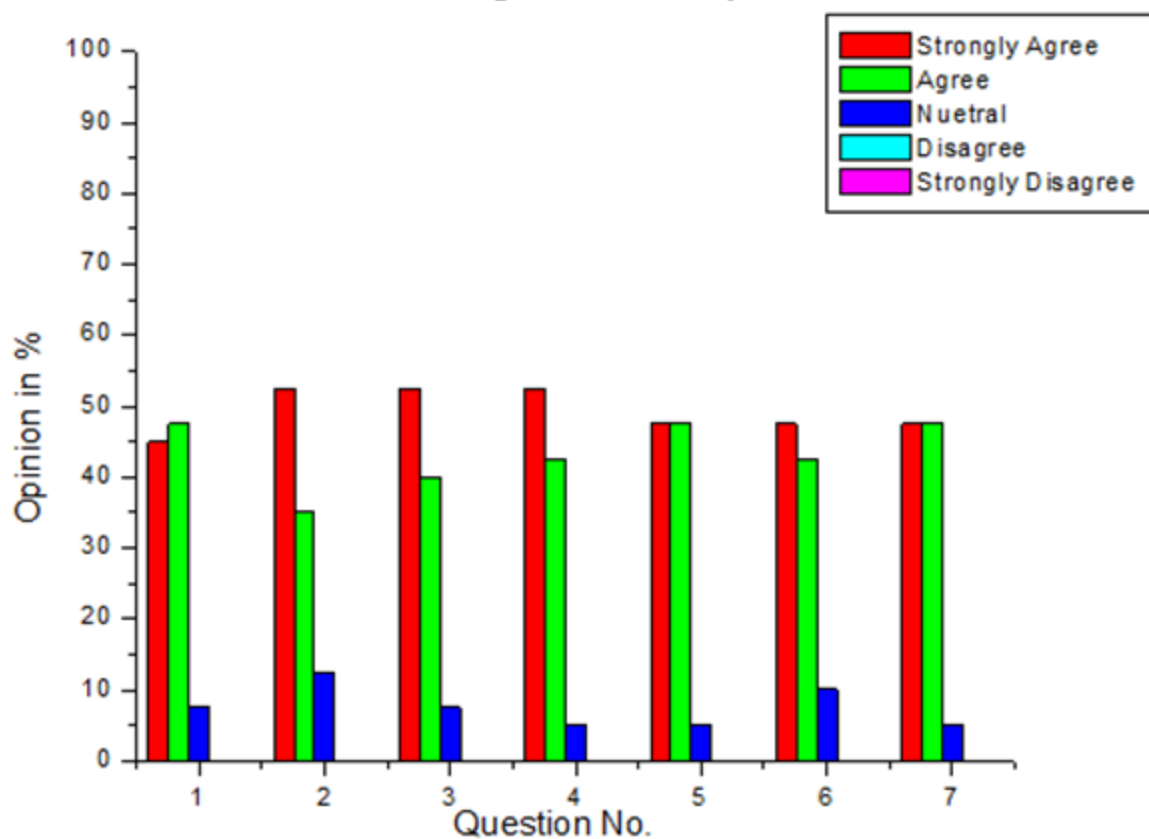

**Suggestion:**

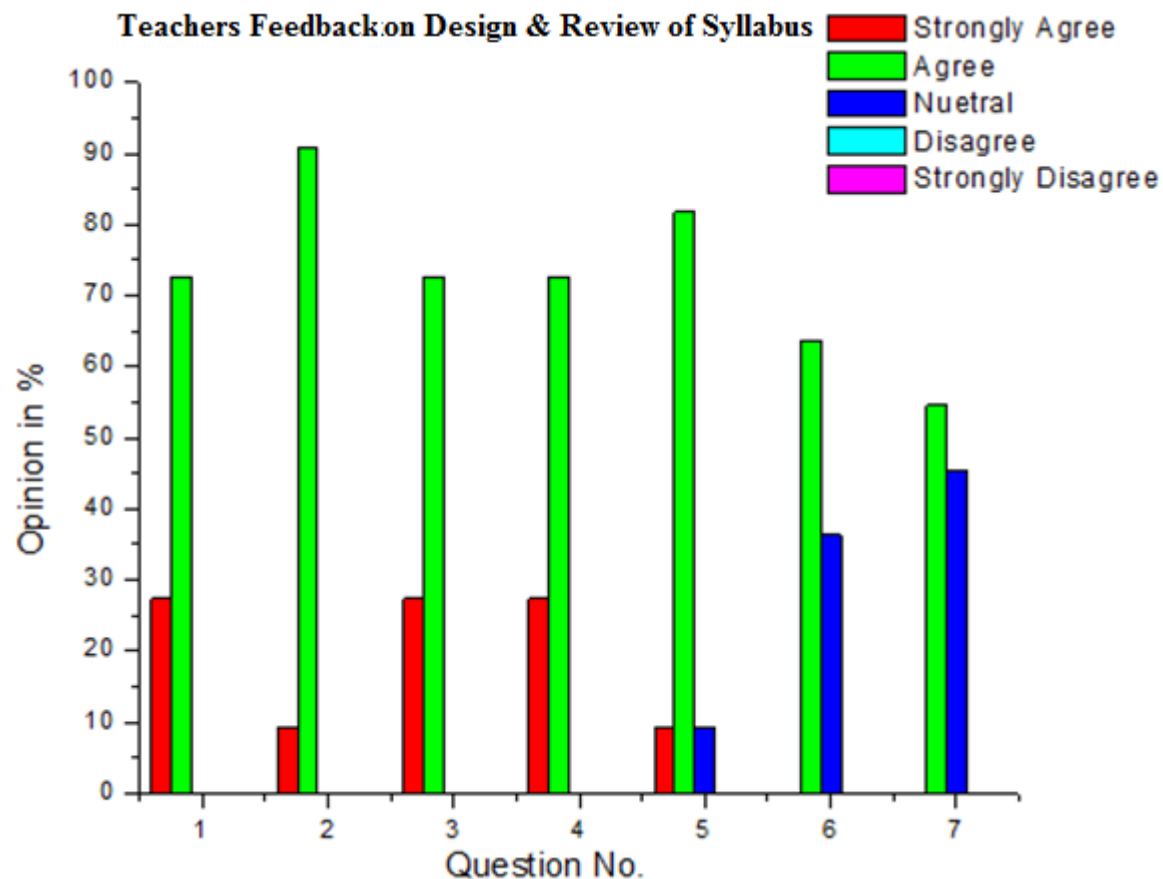
1. Practical based topics should be included.

Skill based design of curriculum will be needed

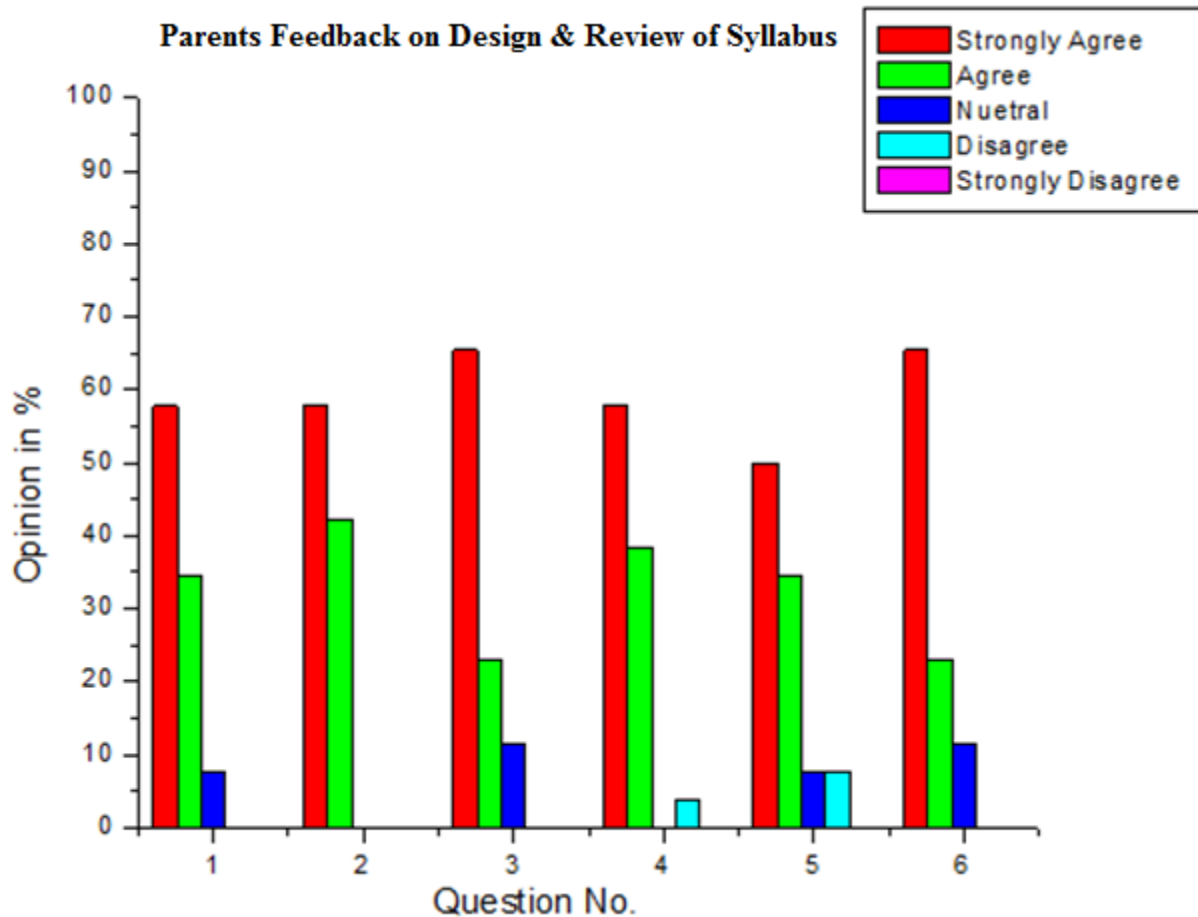

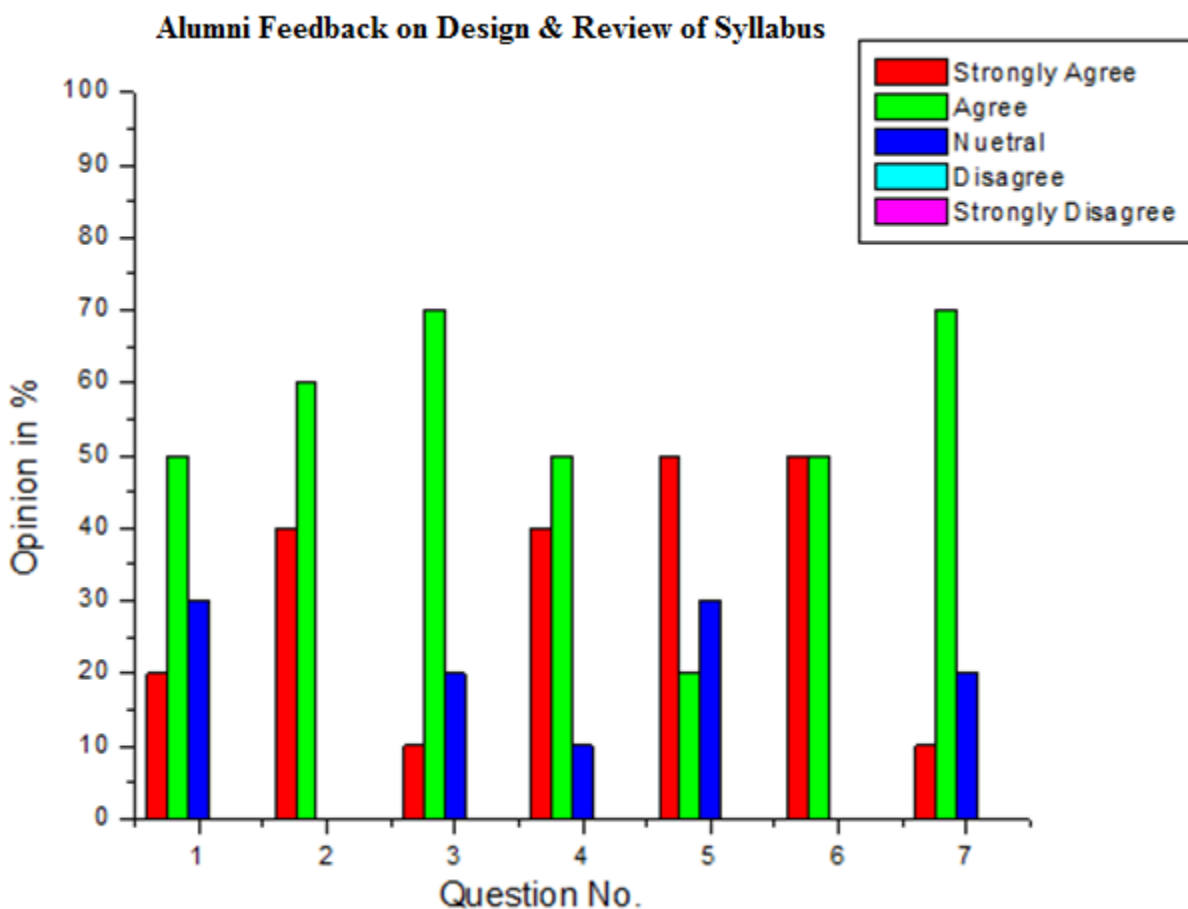
1. Skill base subject should be included in the curriculum.
