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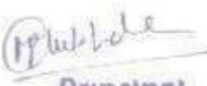

Objective:


To promote gender equality, inclusiveness, tolerance, harmony among the students and the staff leading to women empowerment.

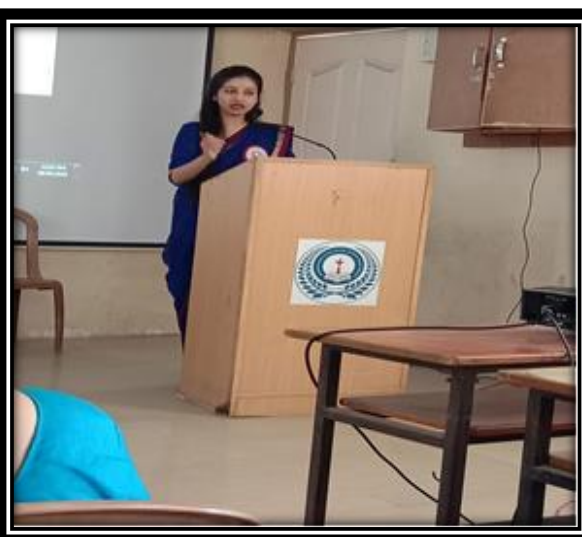

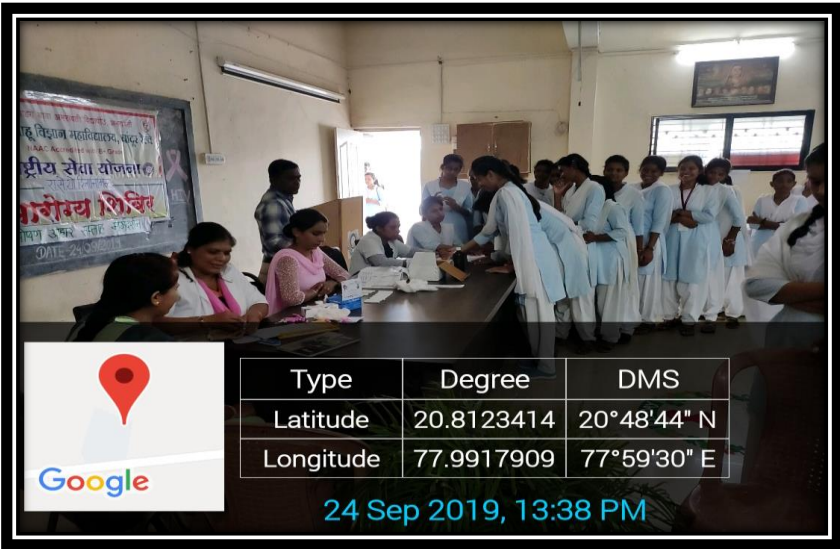
Health Camp on the occasion of NSS Day 2019-2020

National Webinar on Women's Safety" at Workplace and Management of stress in life 2020 -2021

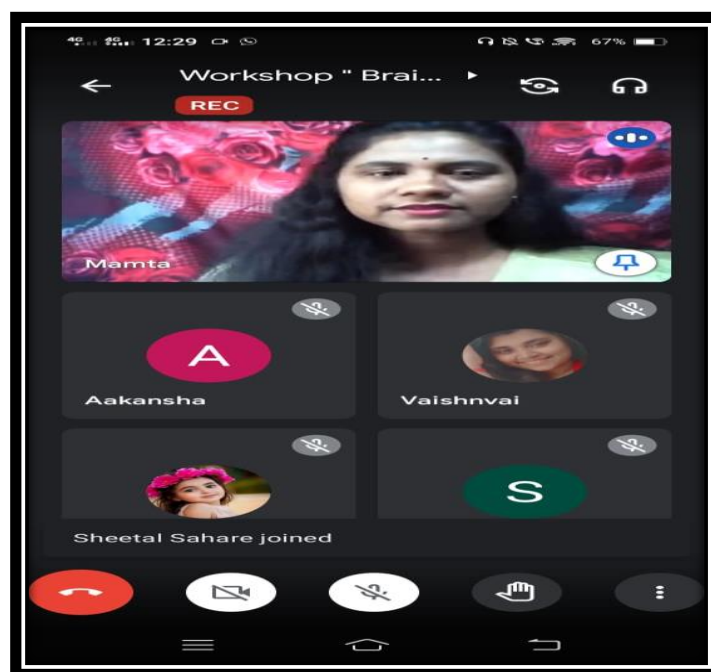

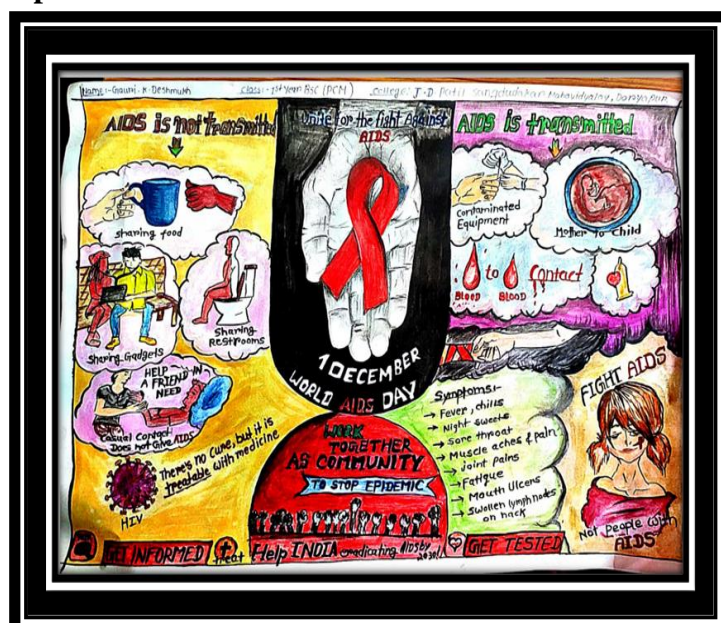
Inter-Collegiate Online Poster Competition on Theme “AIDS awareness (End Inequalities-End AIDS)”.

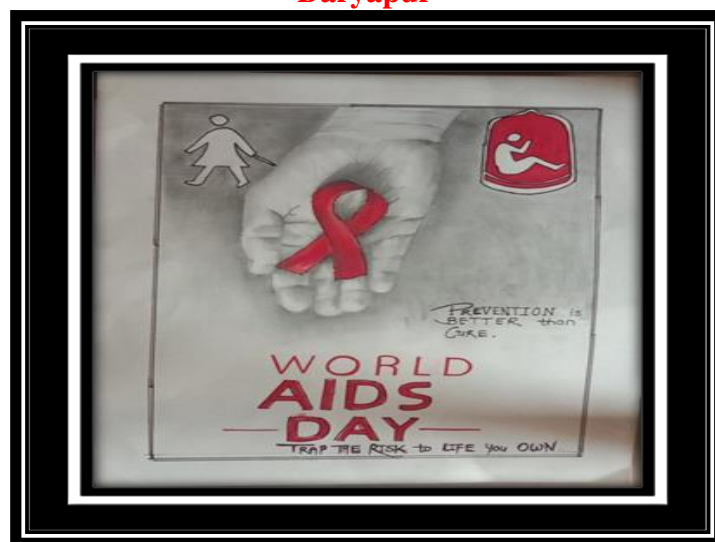

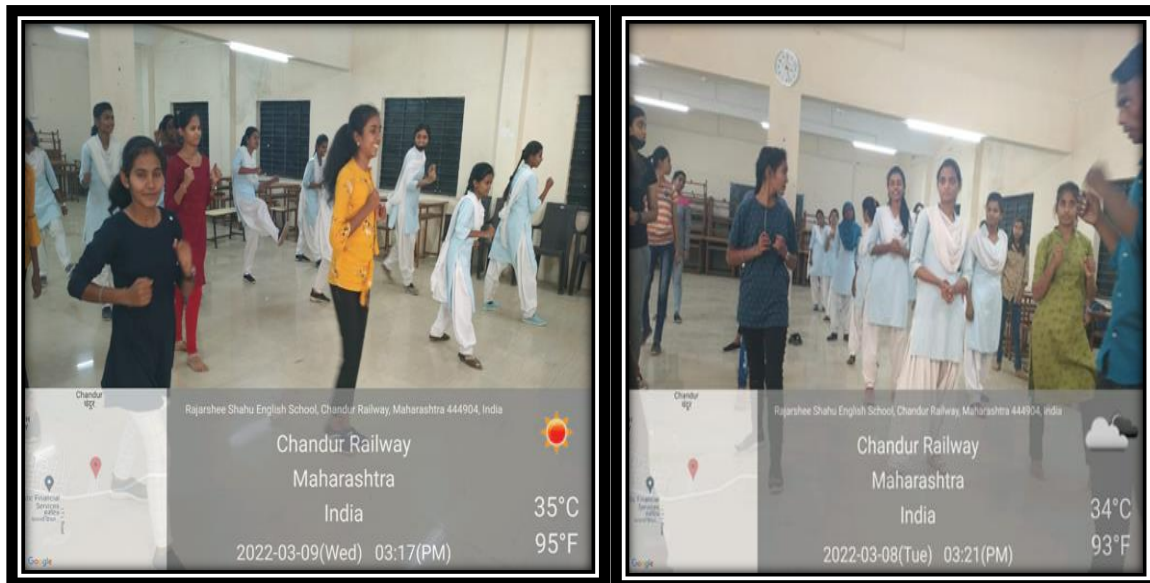
Celebration of International Women's Day 2021-2022

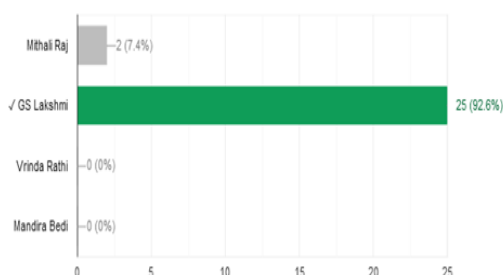

1. Who is the first woman in India to be appointed to the ICC International Panel of Match Referees?

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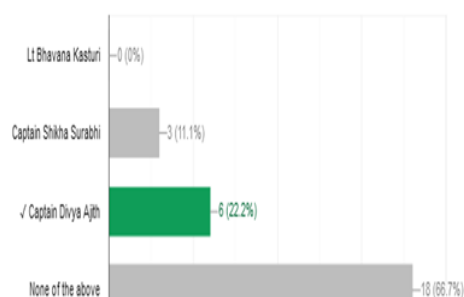
